

Televisions, refrigerators, washing machines, clothes dryers, and air conditioners cannot be collected by the city for recycling.

♦Others

--Engine oils, scooters, fire extinguishers, tires, car and bike parts, etc. cannot be collected by the city for recycling. Other items such as bowling balls, safes, pianos, farm equipment, agricultural chemicals, paint, and propane gas are also ineligible for collection.

Disposal Method

Contact the shop where you purchased the item, or take the items to a specialty shop to inquire about proper disposal method.
